**Gift of the Givers Foundation's Disaster Response Implementation Strategy in KZN and Gauteng as of Wednesday 14 July 2021 Onwards**

We hereby request funding for humanitarian relief in the context of food and medical aid toward the current crisis in KwaZulu-Natal and Gauteng.

Please be advised that this is merely a guideline and since the situation is of a fluid nature, implementation strategies may be altered to serve that circumstance. Furthermore, a deep needs analysis and other budgetary forecasts will be prepared in later reports.

**The current situation demands of us to allocate funding toward:**

1. Emergency Response – The supply of humanitarian aid which includes food, medicine and hygiene packs to care homes, impaired and people with disabilities, women and child headed homes, the elderly, communities affected by the violence;
2. Restoring the Supply Chain Mechanism at Hospitals – Clinics and medical services via the supply of medicine, medical equipment, ambulances, oxygen etc;
3. Financial assistance to Micro and Small Businesses – We are rolling out a financial and stock assistance package to enable communities to become self-reliant thus aiding the recovery of the local economy; and
4. Engaging with Stakeholders – From the various sectors including government, the private sector, civil society representatives and fellow NGO's to respond to this crisis in a transparent, effective and efficient manner.

We will issue an updated report in the coming week reporting back on our progress in this crisis and the way forward.

Ultimately, we seek a solution that resolves these socio-economic issues in a sustainable manner and move away from the vortex of perpetual cycles of economic, social and political instability and upheaval.

Kindly be advised that all COVID-19 protocols and Level 4 regulations apply. The POPIA act has also been implemented more rigidly therefore photographs and other visuals may be difficult to obtain at times.
